

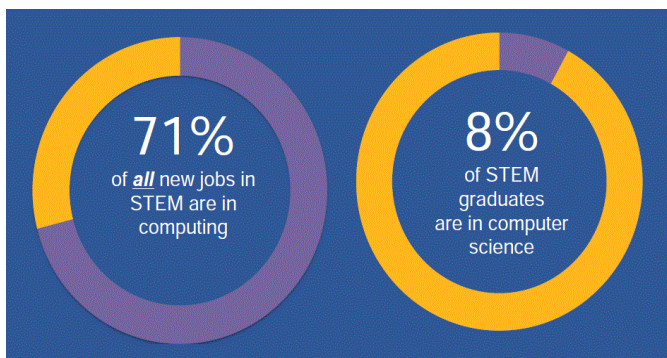

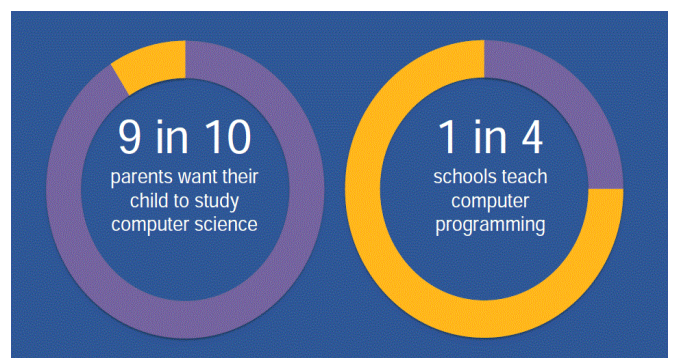
Do you know that in New York State Computer Science counts towards high school graduation for Math and Science requirements?

Would you like to see your students taking a new 'AP Computer Science Principles' course?

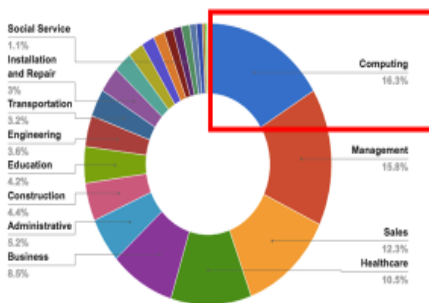

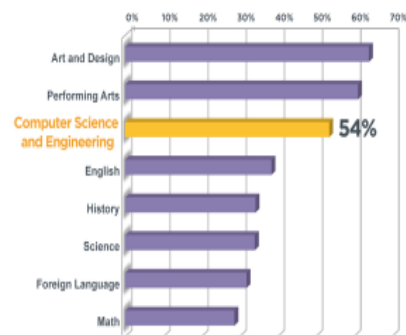
